This free standing kinetic sculpture is viewer operated via the largest hand crank. By rotating this crank the viewer causes the two discs on the other side of the sculpture to rotate in opposite directions. These two disks will hold the images, one, a man running and the other being a hydrogen bomb exploding.

The sculpture will require a power outlet in order to light the lamp located in the aluminum cylinder.

I have included three images of this sculpture due to its seemingly complex mechanics.

This piece is not yet finished and requires several more hours of work.
